Product Test Conditions

LUXEON 5050 LEDs are tested and binned with a DC drive current of 160mA at a junction temperature, T_i, of 25°C.

Part Number Nomenclature

Part numbers for LUXEON 5050 follow the convention below:

L 1 5 0 - A A B B 5 0 2 4 0 0 0 0 0

Where:

A A - designates nominal ANSI CCT (27=2700K, 30=3000K, 40=4000K, 50=5000K, 57=5700K)

B B - designates minimum CRI (70=70CRI, 80=80CRI, 90=90CRI)




Figure 1. Typical normalized power vs. wavelength for L150-xxxx502400000 at test current, T_j=25°C.




Figure 2. Typical normalized light output vs. junction temperature for L150-xxxx502400000 at test current.




Figure 3. Typical normalized light output vs. forward current for L150-xxxx502400000, T_i=25°C.




Figure 4. Typical forward current vs. forward voltage for L150-xxxx502400000, T_j=25°C.




Figure 5. Typical radiation pattern for L150-xxxx502400000 at test current, T_j =25°C.




Figure 6. Typical polar radiation pattern for L150-xxxx502400000 at test current, T_j =25°C.

Product Bin and Labeling Definitions

Decoding Product Bin Labeling

In the manufacturing of semiconductor products, there are variations in performance around the average values given in the technical datasheet. For this reason, Lumileds bins the LED components for luminous flux or radiometric power, color point, peak or dominant wavelength and forward voltage.

LUXEON 5050 LEDs are labeled using a 3-digit alphanumeric CAT code following the format below:

A B C

Where:

- designates luminous flux bin (example: H=450 to 500 lumens, L=600 to 650 lumens)
- **B** designates color bin (example: 3=3 SDCM, 5=5 SDCM parts)
- **C** designates forward voltage bin (example: A=23.5 to 25.0V)

Therefore, a LUXEON 5050 with a lumen range of 600 to 650, color bin of 3 and forward voltage range of 23.5 to 25.0V has the following CAT code:

L 3 A

Luminous Flux Bins

Table 5 lists the standard luminous flux bins for LUXEON 5050 LEDs. Although several bins are outlined, product availability in a particular bin varies by production run and by product performance. Not all bins are available in all CCTs.




Figure 7. 3- and 5-step MacAdam ellipse illustration for hot-color targeting expected at 85°C.








Figure 8. Mechanical dimensions for LUXEON 5050.




Figure 9. Visualization of the acceptable reflow temperature profile as specified in Table 8.




Figure 10. Recommended PCB solder pad layout for LUXEON 5050.




Figure 11. Pocket Tape dimensions for LUXEON 5050.




Figure 12. Reel dimensions for LUXEON 5050.
